## **Expository Writing Prompt:**

Over your summer break, you and some of your friends visited Stone Mountain Park. You all climbed to the top of Stone Mountain. On your hike up the mountain you noticed pieces breaking off, so you picked a small piece to take home. Your science teacher told you that Stone Mountain was made of granite. When you got home you showed the rock to your parents and told them about your trip. Explain to your parents what type of rock you found and how it formed.

## **Persuasive Writing Prompt:**

You and your brother love playing in the creek near your apartment building. One day this spring you found a rock that had black and white bands on it. You told your brother that the rock must have been deep underground at one time and is a Metamorphic Rock.
